



Is your family in a temporary living situation?

Your student may qualify for extra school support services!

Your child may be able to receive help at school through a federal law called the **McKinney-Vento Act** if you live in a:

- **Shelter, motel, vehicle, or camping ground**
- **On the street**
- **Doubled-up** with family or friends (for financial reasons)
- Or any other **temporary/inadequate** housing

Under the McKinney-Vento Act, students in temporary housing may get to:

- Work with the school district's McKinney-Vento Liaison to access and coordinate services.
- Attend either their local school OR the school they attended when they lost permanent housing, if this is in their best interest.
- Receive **FREE** transportation to and from their school.
- Enroll in school immediately, even if they are missing documents such as a birth certificate or proof of residence.
- Have equal access to the same programs as all other students, including special-education services and athletics.
- Eat free meals at school.
