*** IMPORTANT - SAVE *** EMERGENCY, SNOW AND ICE BULLETIN

Dear Parent or Guardian,

The winter months occasionally bring weather conditions which require school delays or closures. Each family should have a plan covering what to do when children arrive home early due to an emergency situation. Arrangements have been made with radio and TV stations to broadcast information regarding the operation of school during emergency situations. Please listen to announcements throughout the a.m. and the day, as weather conditions can cause changes to previous announcements. Please, do not call the schools or the Transportation office.

NO ANNOUNCEMENT MEANS NORMAL OPERATION

Announcements will be heard as follows:

1. **SCHOOLS CLOSED**- All district schools are closed and all scheduled activities at the schools are canceled for that day and evening.
2. **BUSES ON SNOW ROUTES**-See below for route changes. Also, there will be **No AM or PM transportation for Preschool, ECEAP, Head Start, PSSC, Special needs or Out of District Taxi Services.**
2. **TWO HOURS LATE** - Buses will start their routes two hours late, a.m. only. Schools will start two hours late. **No AM or PM Special Ed Preschool, ECEAP, Head Start or PSSC, Out of District Transportation, or Special Needs. No Taxi Services.**

Other announcements may be made but will be self-explanatory. The following stop changes will be in effect when **Buses on Snow Routes** is announced. Other route changes may occur if the bus driver determines that road conditions are unsafe.

Foster/Showalter Routes:

Bus #11 – Stop on 65th/153rd will be picked up on 65th/Southcenter

Bus #3 – All stops will be picked up on 160th/42nd

Elementary School Routes:

Bus #10-Stops on 53rd/142 & 53/139 will be picked up on 144th/53rd

Bus #8- Stop on 130th/37th will be picked up on 128th/37th

Bus #3- Stops on 160th/46 & 160th/43 & 4421/158th & 44th PL/156th will be picked up on 160th/42nd

All other routes and stops will remain unaffected

The following radio and TV stations will be broadcasting emergency school announcements:
